

Do you need a power outlet in Saint Lucia?

In Saint Lucia they use type G outlets. This is different from the United States. So,make sure to bring a travel adapter. Type A and B plugs don't fit into type G outlets. Without a converter, you risk serious damage to your devices. Additionally, be aware that the frequency in Saint Lucia differs. You need a voltage converter in Saint Lucia to protect your devices!

What is the supply voltage in Saint Lucia?

In Saint Lucia the supply voltage is 230V. If the appliance is a single voltage rated appliance, it will need to operate at the same voltage as the supply voltage of the country i.e. 230V. If this is not the case it should be used alongside a voltage transformer or converter to allow the appliance to work safely and properly.

What type of plug does Saint Lucia use?

It is important to note that it does not convert the voltage or frequency. For Saint Lucia the associated plug type is G,which is the plug that has three rectangular pins in a triangular pattern. Saint Lucia operates on a 230V supply voltage and 50Hz. Electricity supplies worldwide can vary from anything between 100V and 240V.

Will a travel adapter work in Saint Lucia?

In Saint Lucia the standard voltage is 240V with a frequency of 50Hz. This doesn't match the 120V standard in the United States. Therefore,not every device will workwith just a travel adapter. Always check if your devices are compatible with different voltages. A voltage converter is likely necessary for some devices.
