

The 300 Yutong E12 battery electric buses will help Uzbekistan to lead the electric and low-carbon transformation of public transport in Central Asia. New energy bus sets a model for Belt and Road cooperation. At present, Yutong has exported more than 86,000 buses, with a global market share of more than 10%.

The batch including 500 compressed natural gas (CNG) buses and 300 electric buses is so far China's largest bus export to Uzbekistan. The buses will be delivered to a bus company in Uzbekistan's Tashkent in batches and help local public transportation go green, according to Li Haifeng, project manager of Yutong Bus in Uzbekistan.

The Chinese company noted that 300 electric buses delivered to Uzbekistan became the largest order for China for e-buses this year. Earlier, it was reported that Uzbekistan will purchase 200 eighteen-meter and 500 twelve-meter buses running on CNG, as well as 300 twelve-meter electric buses for Tashkent.
